

U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Cultural Resources Management Plan

Marshall County, Minnesota

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service retained the 106 Group to prepare a cultural resources management plan (CRMP) to be used as part of a comprehensive conservation plan for Agassiz National Wildlife Refuge (ANWR) in Marshall County, Minnesota.

The CRMP provided a context for long-term planning, established goals, identified project stakeholders, identified historical properties within ANWR, and provided a discussion of their potential eligibility for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The 106 Group also addressed legal mandates to be met through the implementation of the CRMP and recommended specific measures that should be used to meet these goals. This document guided long-term planning for the ANWR and was developed in a style conducive to staff use and implementation.
