

Bruce Vento Nature Sanctuary Archaeological Studies and Historic Preservation

St. Paul, Minnesota

The 106 Group worked in partnership with the City of St. Paul, the National Park Service, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), tribal representatives, and the local community in the planning and restoration of land at Lower Phalen Creek in St. Paul.

This project consisted of trails construction, as well as restoration of vegetation and wetlands. There were many archaeological, historical, and cultural resources representing many centuries of human activity in this area. Significant sites included the 19th century North Star Brewery and Carver's Cave/Wakan Tipi—a cave of great significance to Native people.

The 106 Group assisted the city with all its historic preservation needs including drafting the Programmatic Agreement and conducting archaeological studies.
