

Cedar Rapids Architectural History Survey

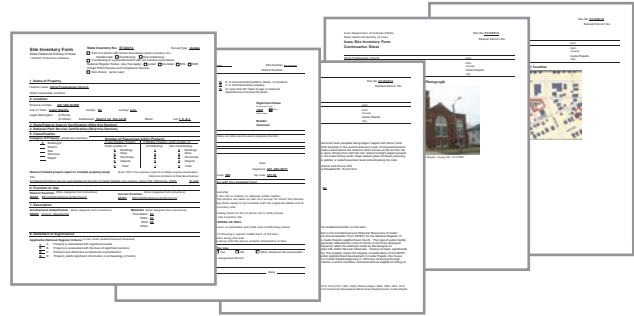
Cedar Rapids, Iowa



The 106 Group conducted an architectural history survey for the Department of Community Development—Housing Services in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

This survey was undertaken so that the city, which regularly receives grants from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), would be in compliance with federal regulations concerning historic properties.

The final results were presented in a very user-friendly format acceptable to the Iowa State Historic Preservation Office. The 106 Group developed a database that would allow the city to produce individual forms and add or update properties as needed.
