

St. Anthony Falls Interpretive Plan

The Minnesota State Legislature charged the St. Anthony Falls Heritage Board with the responsibility of identifying interpretive opportunities and implementing interpretive projects conducive to the development and enrichment of the Heritage Zone located along the Minneapolis Riverfront.

The 106 Group led the effort to evaluate the efficacy of the existing interpretive plan (created in 1990) and made recommendations for future action. Our approach was designed to infuse new life into this nationally significant and historic place.

Working with local residents, agencies, developers, and other stakeholders, the 106 Group proposed a new vision and direction for interpretation and design of the Heritage Zone that will guide planning and development into the future.
