

LSr, Southern Lights, and Alberta Clipper Pipelines Cultural Resources Survey

300+ Mile Corridor across Minnesota, North Dakota, and Wisconsin



The LSr, Southern Lights, and Alberta Clipper projects are a number of proposed parallel crude oil pipelines that will run from Manitoba to Wisconsin. The 106 Group is currently surveying the more than 300 mile corridor across North Dakota, Minnesota, and Wisconsin in support of Enbridge, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and the U.S. Department of State obligations under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.



Our work includes identifying, evaluating, and analyzing the effect of the project on archaeological sites and historic buildings and structures. The project also crosses tribal lands and the 106 Group has been assisting Enbridge and the U.S. Department of State (DOS) in facilitating tribal consultation efforts. The 106 Group has also been assisting Enbridge in consulting with the DOS concerning the Section 106 process. The survey work has proceeded seamlessly and on schedule.
