

# Historic Murphy's Landing Concept Master Plan

*Shakopee, Minnesota*



The 106 Group worked with Three Rivers Park District in developing an interpretive plan and concept master plan for this living museum along the banks of the Minnesota River.



The site includes a broad range of cultural resources, including burial mounds, Native American and Euro-American archaeological sites, and over thirty 19th-century buildings moved onto the property. The plans articulated an interpretive concept for the site, prioritized treatment of the resources, and developed a concept for a new visitor center.

The process included consultation with many stakeholders, including government agencies, staff, volunteers, and the local Dakota community. A thorough and systematic archaeological survey was conducted to ensure development projects do not destroy important resources and sites.
