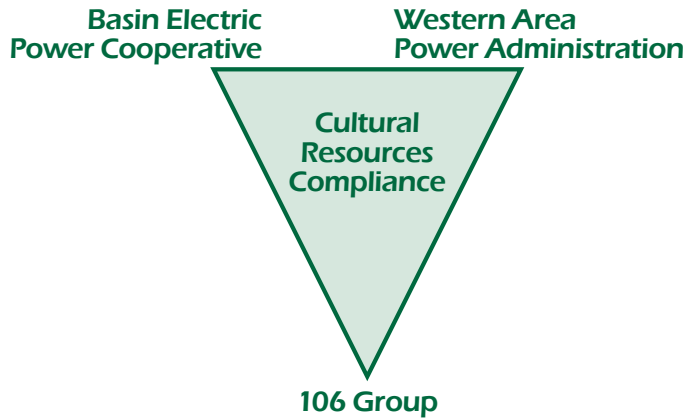


NextGen 3rd Party Cultural Resources Review

South Dakota



The 106 Group is working closely with Western Area Power Administration and Basin Electric Power Cooperative to assist with all cultural resources compliance mandates.

The NextGen project in South Dakota is a proposed baseload energy conversion facility with associated linear utilities. Four alternative plant site locations, as well as multiple potential corridors for water pipelines (totaling 121 miles) and electric transmission lines (totaling 331 miles), have been identified. In addition, there are three alternative water intake locations on the Lake Oahe Reservoir, which is part of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Missouri River Mainstem Reservoir System.

The 106 Group is part of the 3rd party contractor team assisting Western Area Power Administration and Basin Electric Power Cooperative to meet their obligations under federal and state statutes. The 106 Group is providing cultural resources review and agency support for National Environmental Policy Act and National Historic Preservation Act compliance.
