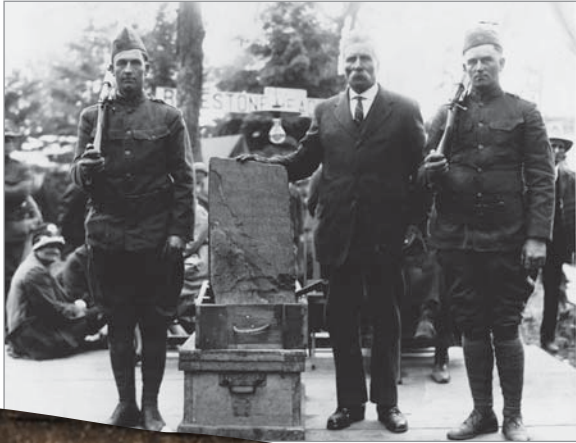


Kensington Runestone Park Preservation and Interpretive Plan

Douglas County, Minnesota



In cooperation with the park's planning consultant, the 106 Group was engaged by Douglas County to develop a master plan for the Kensington Runestone County Park. The park is the discovery site of the famed and controversial Kensington Rune Stone. The legendary stone has traveled the world over and has been the subject of scholarly study and debate since its discovery in 1898.

The 106 Group conducted a historical evaluation, as well as prepared a preservation and interpretive plan for the park. The plan deftly addressed controversial issues to develop an interpretive strategy that encourages the park visitor to develop his or her personal opinion and passion for the Rune Stone's story.
